Representative Cromer

Sought to require a comparison of life and annuity contracts against a Death Master File every 6 months

Effective August 1, 2014

Amends the Louisiana Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association Law

Additional requirements for home service contract providers



House Bill No. 1195
Representative Lorusso
Effective August 1, 2014

Expands unfair trade practices with respect to producers and notice of defense costs



Senate Bill No. 178
Senator Morrish, et al
Effective August 1, 2014

Creates the "health care sharing ministry"



Senate Bill No. 247
Senator Morrish
Effective August 1, 2014

Expands the definition of "fraudulent insurance acts" to include certain acts to defraud an insurer



Senate Bill No. 57
Senator Broome
Effective August 1, 2014

Requires any health policy issued in Louisiana to include an option to cover benefits for lymphedema



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
