All requests for the return of conformed copies of filings must be accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

In accordance with Uniform Rule 2-12.7 that allows the Court to establish the briefing schedule in cases with multiple appellants, the following briefing schedule is hereby established:

ALL Appellant briefs: 07/19/2021
ALL Appellee briefs: 08/08/2021
ALL Reply briefs: 08/18/2021 *

Note, if an appellant is granted an extension, his due date is extended in accordance with the signed order AND the due date is automatically extended for all appellee briefs 20 days and for all reply briefs 30 days from this appellant's new due date. An extension of an appellant's briefing due date will not affect the briefing due date for the other appellant briefs.

Futhermore, if an appellee is granted an extension, his due date is extended in accordance with the signed order AND the due date is automatically extended for all reply briefs 10 days from the appellee's new due date. An extension of an appellee's briefing due date will not affect the briefing due date for the other appellee briefs.

If an appellant fails to file his appellant brief by his due date, a notice of abandonment (NOA) as to his appeal only will issue, giving him 30 days to file his appellant brief or his appeal only will be dismissed. When an NOA is issued, the due date is automatically extended for all appellee briefs 20 days and for all reply briefs 30 days from the NOA due date. The issuance of an NOA for one appellant will not affect the briefing due date for the other appellant briefs. (NOTE also: in NOA situations, the late appellant loses the right to file a reply brief).

Finally, the Court does not require the filing of multiple briefs; however, if an appellant wishes to file one brief as appellant and appellee to other appellants, this appellant must file his consolidated brief on or before his appellant briefing due date.

*EXCEPTION: if an appellee brief is filed late, an appellant who has timely filed a brief will automatically be given 10 days from the filing date of the late appellee brief to file a reply brief in response to that late appellee brief only.


