#### U.S. Attorneys

- Appointed by President. Each judicial district has a U.S. Attorney.
- Chief federal law enforcement officer in the district and responsible for enforcing federal criminal laws.
- Represents federal government in civil matters.
- Manages community programs.



#### U.S. Attorney's Office

- Headquartered in the Russell B. Long Federal Courthouse in downtown Baton Rouge.
- Approximately 60 total staff.
- Criminal, Civil, and Administrative Divisions
- Covers a nine-parish region centered around Baton Rouge with a population of around one million.



#### U.S. Attorney's Office Leadership

- U.S. Attorney leads the office and has wide discretion on how to handle matters in the district.
- First Assistant U.S. Attorney Corey Amundson serves as second-in-command.
- The office is part of the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) which is led by U.S. Attorney General Eric Holder.



- Approx. 144 defendants prosecuted in FY 2014

#### National Security

- > Top Priority
- Senior prosecutor is Anti-Terrorism Advisory Council (ATAC) on the Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF).
- ➤ JTTF focused on preventing and investigating terrorism and national security-related crimes in the district.

#### Advantages of Federal Prosecution

- Independence
  - USAs are not elected
  - AUSAs are career attorneys
  - Federal judges are appointed for life
  - Jury pool is larger
- Resources and reach
- Sentencing Guidelines



#### Federal/State Differences

- Fed: Jurisdiction limited.
- Fed: Prosecutor and investigator work together before an arrest.
- Fed: Long term investigations
- Fed: Plea bargaining limited
- Fed: Guidelines reduce sentence variances



#### Healthcare Fraud



- Strike Force established in 2009
- One of nine of the country
- > 72 defendants charged
- > 98.6% conviction rate
- Convictions involving \$100+ million in fraud

#### Operation Illegal Motion

- Bribery in criminal and traffic matters
- Senior Assistant City Prosecutor
- Three Court Employees
- Two Police Officers
- Chief Public Defender Investigator

#### Operation Snake Eyes

- 18 defendants convicted
- Sentences range 210-327 months
- > \$1,000,000 seized



#### Operation Gator Bait

- > 16 defendants convicted
- Ringleader sentenced to 293 months
- > > \$700,000 seized



- Responsibilities of the Civil Division
  - Defend the United States in civil litigation.
  - Sue to recover wrongfully obtained federal funds.
  - Collect criminal and civil debts owing to the United States.



#### FY 2014

- Collected \$1,138,286 in criminal debt
- Collected \$1,389,373 in civil debt
- Obtained \$1.2 civil judgment against Sabine Optical for wrongdoing obtained healthcare funds.



# U.S. Attorney's Office Outreach Programs

- Louisiana Law Enforcement for Gun Safety (LEGS)
  - ➤ USAO is a founding partner in 2013, along with local law enforcement agencies.
  - Over 20,000 children taught gun safety
  - > Expanded to other Louisiana districts
  - Expansion to Alabama planned
