All Property and Casualty Insurers authorized to write fire and allied lines and/or homeowners' insurance in the state of Louisiana are given notice that Advisory Letter 2020-01, which was originally issued on March 11, 2020, is rescinded.

Advisory Letter 2020-01 was issued to provide guidance to property and casualty insurers on the interpretation of <u>La. R.S. 22:1460(I)(1)</u> concerning fire insurance policies' premiums and rates. The Louisiana Department of Insurance's interpretation of <u>La. R.S. 22:1460(I)(1)</u> is no longer supported by current law. Consequently, Advisory Letter 2020-01 is hereby rescinded.
