To protect personal privacy under La.Const.Art. I, §5, the LDI may redact personal identifiers from certain records disclosed under a public records request. Records containing such personal data identifiers will continue to be available at the LDI as unredacted records until they cease to have administrative value to the LDI. Examples: Social Security numbers, names of minor children, financial account numbers.
